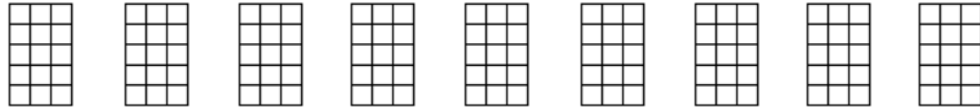


HONOLULU, I AM COMING BACK AGAIN
