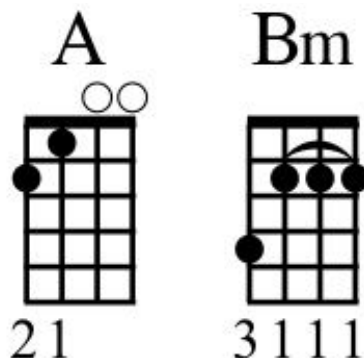


# I'd Rather Go Blind
