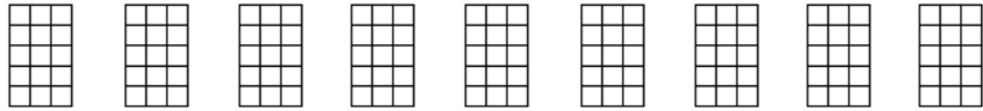


I'M CONFESSIN
