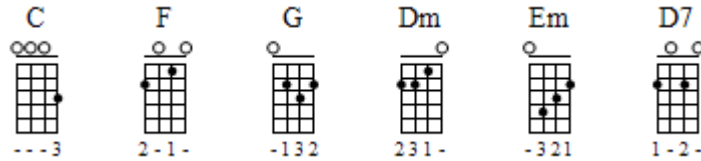


Year End Letter
